Police Chief Christopher Hernandez with Grand Isle Police Dept. was recognized and reports on the following for August 9, 2024 to August 22, 2024: Total callouts 100, medicals 11, total arrest & total summons 9, total citations 29, total violations 34, total golf cart summons 0, court fines paid \$6,773.65, tags sold \$5,925.00.

Jimbo Adams with GIFD was recognized and reports on the following: 1.) Brush fire in between Pine Lane and Birch Lane. 2.) Fire hydrant on LA 1 & Elm Ln needs replacing. JP contacted the contractor to repair. 3.) Council Member James Cheramie asked if the GIFD received their check book back from JP.

Joseph Chauvin with GIS Engineering was recognized and reports on the following: FEMA Updates – 2021 Hurricane Ida still in progress. Cheniere Fishing Pier – Approximately 160 ft to complete job. Old Jail Bunkhouse – Contract awarded to Vella Builders. Contract amount \$155,885.00. NTP August 14, 2024. TOGI Pump Station Pump Station – Sea Level Construction. Project is currently in the 45 day clear lien. Multiplex Building – Picciola Construction contract amount \$621,784.00. Jackson Lane Pump Station – Completing design for pump station. Permits are under review. Orange Ln Pump – Bid opened 7/24/24. Sealevel base bid \$2,138,683.00. PPDR – 28 total homes have been submitted. Estimated cost \$1.01 Million. Working with property owner on ROE for 118 Olive Lane. Other Business – Dredge is complete for beach nourishment project.
