Permits Updates: Landry Hole & Cypress - DNR required the project to start by May 2022. Orange Lane DNR required start by July 2023. Chighizola pump DNR required to start by March 2024. 5.) PPDR – Working on plans and specs for Batch 1 and Batch 2. GIS is working on cost estimate on the demo of homes. 6.) Town Hall rehab design completed.
