David Bradley, Paul Varnado and Major Colin Westlake with the USACE was recognized and reports on the following: 1.) Stone Repair Contract - * Installation of 2,200 LF of stone dune core, repairs to existing breakwaters, repairs to the western jetty * Installation of the dune core and repairs to the west jetty are complete * Repairs to existing breakwaters are anticipated to be completed by the end of May 2024. 2.) Dune Core Repairs/Beach Nourishment Contract - * Installation of 21,000 LF of clay-filled geotextile core (western half of the project), repairs to the sand-filled geo-tube (eastern half of the project), and restoration of the dune and beach * Clearing, grubbing, and excavation activities are underway in preparation for clay core installation * Anticipated completion in late 2024.
